The Migration Museum staff look forward to welcoming you and your students.

Before your visit:

Please ensure that students understand that Museums are peaceful places for all people to enjoy and there may be other visitors here at the same time

Objects are fragile so please don't touch, unless there is a sign that says 'please touch'

Behaviour management and safety remains the responsibility of the supervising teacher/s at all times while within the museum and grounds

To support teachers and students to have a safe and productive learning experience, the Migration Museum requests the following adult student ratio to be observed:

1:10 for Preschool – Year 2;

1:15 for Year 3 – 12.

Adults/supervisors are expected to stay with their students at all times

Please note:

- We may not be able to run programs for classes without the required numbers of supervisory adults.
- The Museum is to be notified of changes to class size at least one week before visit
- The Museum is to be notified of cancellations at least two weeks before the visit or an administration fee will apply.
